Last meeting's speaker - We were glad to have with us Brigadier General Mark Scheid. Some of us got to talk with him before the meeting plus he had pictures in two binders that were very interesting.

He started off telling us that on Sept. 11th he decided to fly home to be with his wife on her birthday. That was the day of the terrorist attack on the pentagon and if he had stayed, the room they were working in took a direct hit with the nose of the plane.

He along with 2 other's wrote the war plan for Afghanistan. He told of a typical day and the stress that they were under to do this. 6 months later they briefed President Bush with their plan. Only 6 people knew of what was in this and secrecy was pivotal. These 3 people would be the prime suspects if anything leaked.

He then talked about the war in Ukraine and his thoughts on how the war was going and what maybe to expect. Ukraine has 32 other countries supporting them with supplies, arms, etc. He compared both armies and gave us his thoughts on the strategic plans both are using and who had the better plan.

Mark told of a group of Russian soldiers who were in the US back in 1985 and even though he said they didn't want to talk to them, they had to. One question was if they would invade the US. The Russian soldiers said no but not because of our military but because about every civilian had a gun or two in the homes. This makes a very good argument for our 2nd Amendment!

Mark also gave us this thoughts on the military in other countries. He said in his estimation the Indian military is the most up to date and strongest. Thank goodness thought they are one of our Allies! I think he said China was about 3rd.

It was very fascinating listening to him. If you get a chance to hear him speak, I'd encourage you to go listen to him. He puts it in a way you can really understand what is and has gone on in our military.


